Bath Ales

'SPA' (Special Pale Ale) 3.7%

Using pale lager malt to give a golden hue to this ale, Bath Ales have combined a dwarf variety of hop which imparts a citrus aroma. Dry, crisp & full flavoured with no harshness of taste.

'GEM' 4.1%

A rich aroma of hops and malt is combined to give a full flavoured exceptional best bitter. Long and deep tasting with a bitter-sweet finish.

'Wild Hare' 5.0%

A Golden organic pale ale that has a hoppy aroma. A dry-bitter finish, for this excellent beer with full organic accreditation.

Butty Bach 4.5%

Stowford Press LA 1.0%
A cider with only 1% alcohol but plenty of fruity flavour. Contains no artificial colouring, flavouring or sweetening. Suitable for vegetarians, vegans and coeliacs.

Birra Moretti (Italy) 4.6%
A straw coloured lager with a distinctive, delicate malt flavour. The most popular lager in Italy.

Cruzcampo

Cruzcampo (Spain) 5.0%
Cruzcampo has its origins in Seville and is renowned as the classic beer of Andalusia. A premium quality pilsner beer, typically light tasting with a fine balance of malt and hops. It has a floral, aromatic aroma with a dry finish.

La Brasserie de Saverne

Kasteel Cru (Alsace, France) 5.2%
La Brasserie de Severne uses 'Champagne Yeast' to produce a mouth tingling, sparkling lager. Pale in colour with an extremely fresh, dry finish, this elegant lager makes even real champagne seem rather heavy.

A bright, golden beer with a light clean body. It has a distinctive malt accent as opposed to the hoppier brews of the Pilsner style. This style is often identified as Munchner Helles ('pale').

Once a year the brewery adds cherries to some of its brown ale and allows further fermentation. The finished product is deliciously smooth dark and distinctive with a sweet / sour flavour.
